Poster Competition Guidelines

Eligibility

Full-time postgraduate students and postdoctoral fellows enrolled at accredited institutions are invited to submit an abstract for a poster presentation at the 34th ARTP Meeting

Abstract Guidelines

- 1 - Abstract should be submitted in Word format (PDF file are NOT accepted) using the Arial 12 font, with less than 2,000 characters*.
- 2 - Abstract includes the title (ALL CAPS in bold), the list of author lists (the presenting author name should be underlined) in bold; author affiliations in italics.
- 3 - Abstract should be written in a specific format (Background, Methods, Results, and Conclusions).
- 4 - Abstract should be submitted with the agreement of all listed authors.

**The number of characters includes all text in the title, abstract and tables, but excludes spaces, authors' names and institutional affiliations.*

Figures and images are not permitted.

*There is no character limit for the title,
but title characters count towards the overall total.*

**The cut-off date for abstract submission
is October 31, 2025**

Poster size Guidelines

Posters must not exceed 150 cm in height and 100 cm in width, which corresponds to the dimensions of the poster boards provided. Please ensure your poster fits within these limits—oversized posters will not be accommodated.

Presenter Awards

The top three poster presenters will be awarded the ARTP Prize for Prostate Cancer, which includes a monetary award of 300 euros for first, second, and third place winners.
